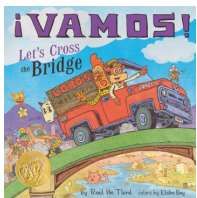


### It's a Sign \*

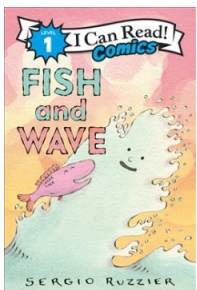

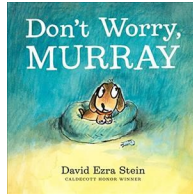


### Fish and Wave \*

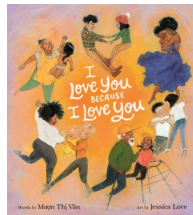


### Don't Worry, Murray

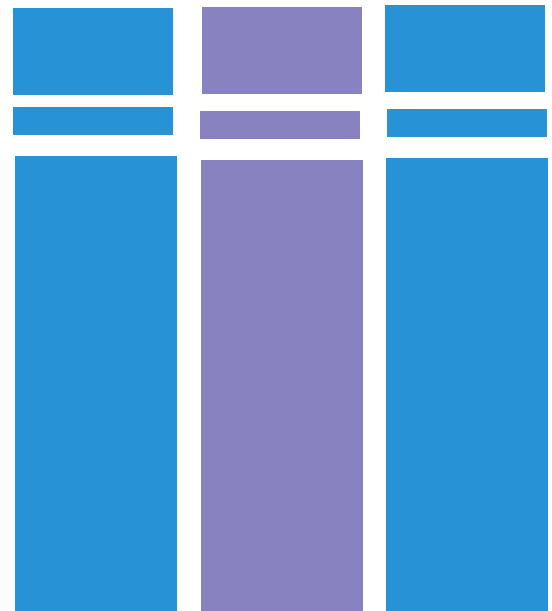

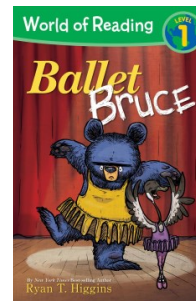


## I am Golden

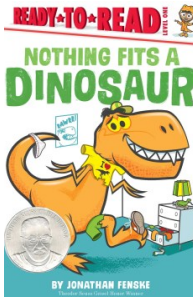


## Starla Jean: Which Came First: the Chicken or the Friendship? \*

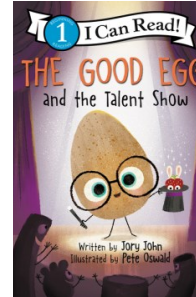


## Nothing Fits a Dinosaur

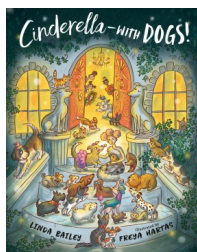


## The Good Egg and the Talent Show \*

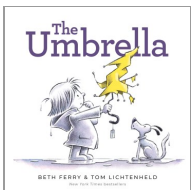


## Cinderella—with Dogs!

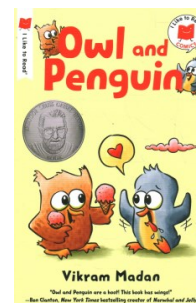


## The Umbrella

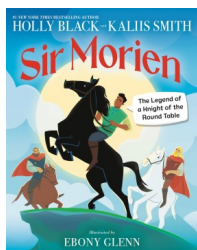

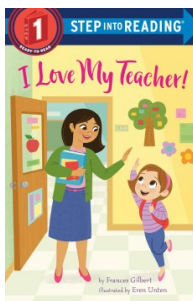


## Sir Morien: the Legend of the Knight of the Round Table

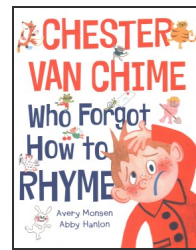


## I Love My Teacher!
